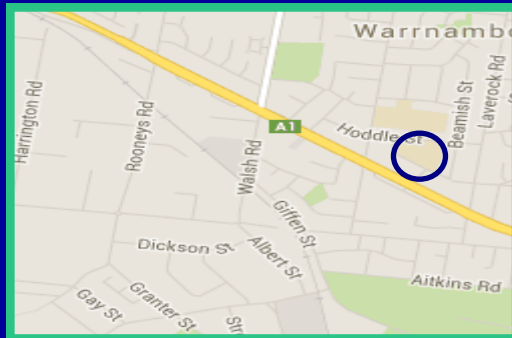

Bullying is:

- * A **repeated** and unjustifiable behaviour.
- * Intended to cause fear, distress and/or harm to another.
- * Physical, verbal or indirect/relational.
- * Conducted by a more 'powerful' individual or group.
- * Against a less powerful individual who is unable to effectively resist.



Bullies Are:

- NOT COOL
- NOT FRIENDLY
- NOT POPULAR
- NOT RESPECTED
- NOT WELCOME
- ALL OF THE ABOVE**

As Parents you can:

- * Take an active interest in your child's social life and friends.
- * Be aware of changes in behaviour and signs of distress.
- * Effectively monitor electronic device usage.
- * Encourage your child to talk freely with teachers or trusted adults.
- * Work co-operatively with the school to resolve issues.
- * Work through the school-do not deal with directly with other students or parents.
- * Be willing to inform the school of any suspected bullying.
- * Encourage your child to be caring towards and tolerant of others.

As a school we have:

- * Zero Tolerance towards bullying.
- * A fulltime Wellbeing Officer.
- * Caring and compassionate staff who are all trained to identify signs of bullying.
- * Alternative Lunchtime Clubs.
- * A Nurture Room – a safe, calming and accepting space.
- * A whole school 'Code of Conduct'.
- * Implemented the "Kids Matter" program
- * Restorative Practices to manage conflict.
- * Strong school values: SAFE, SUPPORTIVE, INCLUSIVE
